

Hanging And Dressing Your Wave Curtains

Your curtains will arrive with the hooks already in place so there are just a few simple steps to follow to make sure they are hung correctly.

The outside edge of the curtain will face back towards the wall.



Simply push each fold backwards and forwards to create the wave effect and insert hooks onto your wave track in succession.

Dressing Your Curtains

When curtains are first hung they should be dressed to encourage them to fall into even folds.

To begin, draw the curtains back.

Start from the outside edge, work from the top downwards and run your hands down each fold making sure they are in neat columns.

Ideally you should now tie your curtains. We recommend you cut strips from the plastic packaging your curtains have been delivered in to tie around the whole curtain. They should hold the folds into position but not be so tight that they mark the fabric.

Leave in position for about 48 hours and then untie.

Your curtains should now hang beautifully.
